To do this we implemented new programs locally such as sack lunch Saturday's, Sunshine Care kits, a reading give back program at local elementary schools, and a partnership with the City of Orem to spread sunshine through their annual "Light's On" event.

Because no anniversary is complete without a celebration, in honor of our 10 years since our founding we executed 10 projects in 10 days! In those 10 days we helped brighten the lives of over 3,000 individuals.

Education brings hope for a brighter future.

Both of the Sunshine Centers in Mali are much needed schools. Education is hope for a brighter future, and each year our schools provide that hope to more and more children.

In 2017, attendance at our Mana location reached 171 students. This school is well staffed with 12 teachers.

The Tanima location has reported improved graduation rates, which we attribute to the teacher trainings that are being facilitated by our partners Mali Rising Foundation.

We are excited to report that both schools are impacting the lives of the children in their communities.

The biggest challenge these schools face each year is access to textbooks. As we continue our active partnership with Mali Rising, we will continue to improve and provide resources to best serve the students of Mali.



Bastimentos continues to be one of the most impactful Sunshine Centers.

In 2015, Sunshine Heroes Foundation partnered with Give & Surf for the first time to build a community center in Panama. The center was finished in November of that year and has seen a lot of use since its grand opening. This year, Sunshine Heroes provided resources to launch additional summer camp and after school programs to benefit the children in Bastimentos. More than a hundred children have already participated in these programs.

As we anticipate the impact of this Sunshine Center to grow, in August additional funding was granted to expand the center to include an outside pavilion, bathroom, and clean water station. Bastimentos continues to be one of the most impactful Sunshine Centers.



New clean water system sustains community in Nicaragua.

Ojochal, Nicaragua is home to our 7th Sunshine Center. This center includes a library, health clinic, garden, playground, and serves as a meeting place for the community. It's impact is more than 3,000 people a year.

For this community, the invaluable resource of clean water is not taken for granted. Earlier in 2017, one of two pumps used to provide clean water for all the citizens of Ojochal was broken, rendering the well incapable of providing fresh water.

During this time Sunshine Heroes was already underway on the installation of a new water system that would provide 10,000 liters of clean water to the community each day. Doubling what the old system could do working at it's prime.

Our ties in this small city of Nicaragua will continue to grow, and families will reap the benefits of clean water, as well as a safe place where they can all retreat to for education, and activities.
